

PURPOSE

The Fort Leavenworth Rod and Gun Club is your on-post organization for the promotion of hunting, fishing, wildlife conservation, and all types of shooting activities. The Club strives to: improve hunting and fishing on-post through close cooperation with the post forester and military land managers; assist in the development of ethical hunters through the Kansas state certified Hunter Education classes; assist the installation with hunting and fishing events; and provide a focal point for conservation activities. The Club's membership is over 400 and growing. The Club is Family oriented, so bring your clan and join us.

EVENTS

The Rod and Gun Club supports an active schedule of activities throughout the year. Events are designed for children, sporting enthusiasts, and the entire Family. Highlighted events include: annual dove hunt, kids' fishing derbies, crappie and bass fishing tournaments, general membership meetings, conservation projects, turkey shoots, shotgun and pistol shoots, dog trials, youth hunts, and informational seminars.

CLUBHOUSE AND MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

The clubhouse is available for members and guests. General membership meetings are normally held the second Wednesday of each month at the Hunt Lodge (down the hill from the clubhouse). A guest speaker is featured at most meetings with topics ranging from information on local fish and wildlife populations to woodcarving, taxidermy, and game processing. Members and their guests have the opportunity to grill steaks on barbecue grills beginning at 5:30 p.m. prior to meetings. Members and guests can purchase and grill a 14oz KC strip steak. Baked potato, sauteed mushrooms and onions, and condiments are included in the base price. Beverages are also available for a nominal fee. Steaks must be ordered no later than three working days prior to the meeting from the Club Entertainment Manager, A.C. Byrd, at (913) 727-1472 or acbyrd40@aol.com. There are door prize drawings at each meeting. Items for hunters, fishermen and the outdoors men are given away based on random drawings of membership cards from those present. The Club has special rates for active duty E-4 and below, as well as other shortterm personnel.

KENNEL FACILITIES

The Rod and Gun Club operates the only public kennel facility on the installation. The outdoor kennels are maintained full time and are reasonably priced. FISHING

The Club sponsors fishing events both on and off-post including kids' fishing derbies and bass and crappie tournaments. Fishing is allowed on installation lakes. Species include: catfish, bass, and bream. All bass must be returned to the water immediately (catch and release only). Creel limits for the other species are posted around the lakes. Kansas state fishing permit requirements apply to on-post lakes. The Club has a Master Angler Program for its members.

HUNTING

The Club sponsors hunting events both on and off-post during the different Kansas State seasons. The reservation currently allows hunting for small game, deer, turkey, upland birds, and waterfowl. Hunters are reminded that Kansas law requires that anyone born on or after the first of July 1957 is required to complete a certified hunter education course. Kansas has reciprocal agreements with other states so if you have completed a course in another state you won't have to take the course again. Proof of completion will be required when you purchase your game tags. The Club has a Master Hunter Program for its members.
