Harrold Youth Center

HYC is the central facility for Middle School and High School-aged youth at Fort Leavenworth. The 9,000 sq foot building houses a gym, a game room, complete with a 120" home theater system, billiard table, table tennis, DDR, air hockey and interactive game wall. HYC also has a homework lab staffed with a certified teacher who partners with the School Liaison Officer (SLO) to provide current curriculum from Patton Jr High and chromebooks for assisting with homework. The building has a tech lab with desktop computers as well as IPads with a wide

variety of educational and leisure software as well as robotics, other electronics and VR. The Art Room provides opportunities for youth to experiment with a wide variety of art mediums. The Club/Music/STEAM Room is used for BGCA Leadership

Clubs and hosts a piano, drums, guitars and ukuleles for musical experiences.

HIGH SCHOOL LOUNGE

The Teen lounge is a dedicated space for 9th-12th graders and was completely remodeled in April 2021. The teen lounge was redesigned with a 120" home theater system, a DJ booth with the state of the art sound and lighting and a large screen TB to play the newest video games. HYC has Wii, Play Station and X-Box.

History

Capt. Patrick K. Harrold, USAF, was reared at Fort Leavenworth. As a family member Patrick was a frequent user of the Patch Youth Center. He graduated from Leavenworth High School, and then attended Kansas State University in Manhattan, KS.

In the spring of 1967 he entered the US Air Force. He married that December, and was assigned to and F4 Phantom Squadron in the Republic of Vietnam. On December 5, 1969 Capt. Harrold was declared missing in action over Laos and on November 19, 1973 was listed as Killed in Action. Capt. Harrold's remains were recovered in 1997, and he was laid to rest with full military honors in Arlington National Cemetery on November 21, 1997.


