FAQs

What do I need to get started?

To participate, you will need a suitable mount, the ability to comfortably trot in open country, a safety helmet, boots, and most importantly, a sense of adventure! Members that enroll in jumping fields are required to be turned out in traditional apparel, tack and appointments.

Are there seasonal rides?

Yes! We offer a Summer Ride Series that has rides for different skill levels. Keep checking for additional options in the future!

Do I need to sign a waiver?

Riders must sign a Hold Harmless agreement, and have proof of negative Coggins test before the ride. Contact us for more info!

Do I need to special equipment?

Riders must wear heeled boots, and ATSM approved helmet.
