

Cosmetic Acknowledgement

Per the Kansas Business Guide and K.S.A. 65-1902 (2006), an individual is required to be licensed with the State Board of Cosmetology if they engage in the practices of cosmetology – if they “perform any other noninvasive beautifying process on any skin surface by means of hand...” (K.S.A. 65-1901 (2006)). To clarify this means that if you apply makeup to your customer for compensation, you are engaging in “cosmetology” in Kansas, thereby requiring a cosmetology license.

I have read the above statement and understand its content. I will not engage in the practice of cosmetology by applying a noninvasive beautifying process on any skin surface by means of hand to any of my customers.
