School Liaison Officer (SLO)

School Liaison Officers provide direct services during a PCS by providing detailed information on local schools and homeschooling. They act as a liaison between Families and schools as newcomers work through key issues addressed by the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children: eligibility, enrollment, placement, and graduation.

SLOs are also a resource for parent education.
