PURPOSE

The Fort Leavenworth Rod & Gun Club is your on-post organization for the promotion of hunting, fishing, wildlife conservation, and all types of shooting activities. The Club is open to all Active Duty and Retired personnel, DoD civilians, and family members. The Club strives to: improve hunting and fishing on-post through close cooperation with the post forester and military land managers, assist in the development of ethical hunters through the Kansas State Certified Hunter Education classes, assist the installation with hunting and fishing events, and provide a focal point for conservation activities. The Club's membership is over 200 and growing! Bring the whole family and join us!

EVENTS

The Rod & Gun Club supports an active schedule of activities throughout the year. There are events geared and available for all ages! Highlighted events include: Annual Dove Hunt, Kids' Fishing Derbies, Fishing Tournaments, Turkey Shoots, Dog Trials, Shooting Events, and more!

CLUBHOUSE & MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

The clubhouse is available for members and guests. General membership meetings are normally held the second Wednesday of every month at the Hunt Lodge (down the hill from the clubhouse). Guest speakers are featured at most meetings with topics ranging from information on local fish and wildlife populations to woodcarving, taxidermy, and game processing. Members and guests are welcome to grill steaks on BBQ grills prior to the meetings beginning at 5:30pm. Members and guests can purchase and grill 14oz KC strip steak from The Club. Steaks must be ordered no later than three working days prior to the meeting from the Club Entertainment Manager, Dave Scharinger, at dschar@lvnworth.com. Baked potatoes, sauteed mushrooms, onions, and condiments are included in the base price. Beverages are also available for a nominal fee.

There are Door Prize drawings at each meeting. Items are given away based on a random drawing of membership cards from those present.

HUNTING & FISHING

HUNTING

The Fort Leavenworth Rod & Gun Club sponsors hunting events both on and off-post during different Kansas State seasons. The reservation currently allows hunting for small games, deer, turkey, upland birds, and waterfowl. Anyone born after July 1, 1957 must complete a certified hunter education course. If you completed a course in another state, a certificate must be presented in order to purchase your game tags. The Club does have a Master Hunter program for its members.

FISHING

The Fort Leavenworth Rod & Gun Club sponsors fishing events both on and off-post including Kids Fishing Derbies, Crappie Tournaments, and Bass Tournaments. Fishing is allowed on installation lakes. Species include: catfish, bass, and bream. All bass must be immediately returned to the water (catch and release only). Creel limits for the other species are posted around the lakes. Kansas State fishing permits apply to on-post lakes. The Club has a Master Angler program for its members.
