Survivor Outreach Services (SOS)

Survivor Outreach Services provides long-term support to surviving Families of the Fallen Soldiers. Our goal is to reassure survivors that they remain valued members of the Army Family. Our Services include: grief counseling, financial counseling, benefits coordination, support groups, and garrison and surrounding area events.

Family Advocacy Program (FAP)

Family Advocacy Program helps Soldiers and Families recognize and meet unique challenges of military lifestyles. Our services include seminars, workshops, counseling, and intervention to help strengthen Army Families, enhance resiliency and relationship skills, and improve quality of life.

→ Victim Advocate Program (VAP)

Victim Advocacy Program helps victims of domestic violence and sexual abuse have round-the-clock access to services, including emergency assistance, information, referrals, and ongoing support in accessing medical, behavioral health, legal, and law enforcement services on and off garrisons. Victim Advocates will discuss the option of restricted and unrestricted reports.
